

## **SHORT BIO:**

**Prof. Rafal Kozubski** completed his Ph.D. from the Jagiellonian University in Kraków in 1984. From 1987 to 1988 he was a post-doc at the Strasbourg Institute of Physics and Chemistry of Materials (IPCMS), France. In 1988 and 1990 he was an academic visitor in the Institute for Applied Physics, Swiss Federal Institute of Technology, Zurich, Switzerland. From October 1993 to September 1995 he stayed at the Institute for Solid State Physics, University of Vienna, Austria as a Lise-Meitner Fellow. After having completed his habilitation (DSc) from the Jagiellonian University in Kraków in 1997 he worked there first as an associate professor (1997 – 2006). In 2006 he was appointed a full professor in the Jagiellonian University in Kraków, Poland. His international experience includes International Fellowship at the Queen's University in Belfast (2006-2008) and visiting professorships at the L.Pasteur University in Strasbourg/University of Strasbourg, France (2007, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011). In 2016 he was appointed a Conjoint Professor of the University of Newcastle, Australia (Honorary Professor from 2021). He published over 100 scientific papers in international reviewed journals and is an author of over 200 communications on international conferences.
